



**Lost Keys - Chart info. January 13<sup>th</sup> 2022 Time: 12:08 Pm in West Hartford CT.**



An elderly woman wrote me an email to help find her lost keys. I sent responded and asked her to call me. She telephoned and explained that she went out walking. When she returned home she used the key to get into her house but the next morning the keys were missing. She told me that she looked everywhere but just did not see them anywhere in the house at all. I then took the time that she called and asked me where her keys were.


Now let's look at the chart. The keys are ruled by Mercury conjunct Saturn in the 10th house in square to Uranus in the 12th house conjunct the Ascendant. The conjunction to Saturn indicates that the keys were mislaid with a lot of other items. It also means that they are near a wall. This is an indication that the keys may be hard to find and/or they were accidentally lost. We also see that the ruler of the keys, Mercury, is station retrograde because Mercury will turn retrograde tomorrow. Again, that's a clue that the keys are not in the open but somewhat hidden. Both the Moon and Mercury are in angles showing a strong possibility of being in her house.

The next thing I did was to bring up a local space chart. Local space charts offer true compass directions. As we see Mercury on this local space chart is points south by 5 to 6° towards East. Seeing that Mercury, ruler of the keys, is in an air sign we need to look on the West wall. With this information I called my client back. This is how I handle situations when a client is looking for a missing item or possession.

These are the instructions I gave her as we spoke on the phone. I told her to stand in the middle of the house and face East which is the direction where the Sun rises. Now I told her to turn 90° clockwise and she should be facing South. Lastly, I told her to turn counterclockwise about 10° and asked her what room would she be in if she walked towards the outside wall of the house. She told me there is a long hall leading to the back door. I said good. Now, I said, walk through and look at everything on the West wall. Look on the floor, inside things, in back of different things, and move furniture if you have, too, and then call me back.

Twenty minutes later she called me and told me the following. 'I wasn't quite sure if I was looking in the right direction so I have a compass on my phone. I used the compass and your direction pointed to the kitchen. I started looking on the West wall like you told me. There is a table there where I keep a lot of junk and on the floor I have a couple of baskets that I also keep things in. I moved everything off the table and I took the baskets one by one and flipped them upside down. When I turned the last one upside down I heard the keys fall on the floor. Thank you so much! I would have never found them on my own.'
